

PRINCE2[®] Conversion Course

A 2-day course for those who already hold the PRINCE2 Foundation certificate and want to go on to gain the PRINCE2 Registered Practitioner qualification.

Delegates will join the last 2 days of the full practitioner course, and so must already hold the Foundation certificate, and be fully conversant with PRINCE2 principles, themes and processes.

The focus of the course will be on applying the method and examination techniques.

Software developers, business users, suppliers, administrators and managers can all benefit from knowledge of how **PRINCE2** projects are structured and managed, and the processes that are involved.

Delegates will gain a detailed understanding of the **PRINCE2** method, and will sit the **PRINCE2** Foundation examination. The examination consists of a 1 hour multiple choice test paper. Successful candidates will receive the internationally recognised **PRINCE2** Foundation certificate.

PRINCE2[®] Practitioner Course

A 5 day course aimed primarily at project managers, but of great value in many other roles, such as:-

- Programme Management
- Project Board (Project Steering Group)
- Project Support Office
- Quality Assurance
- Configuration Management
- Risk Management

Delegates will gain a thorough grounding in the PRINCE2 method, and will apply the method to a given scenario, to ensure that they are able to use the method in practical situations.

The course includes both the Foundation and Practitioner examinations. The Foundation examination is a 1 hour multiple choice test. The Practitioner examination is a 2.5 hour open-book examination leading to the internationally recognised PRINCE2 Registered Practitioner qualification.
